EDVORG Project

About

Educating adults about volunteering and organic food production on farm enterprises (EDVORG) is the focus of this partnership project with national organisations from ten European countries. It will develop and promote a Learning Guide as an online open educational resource (OER) for adult learners about organic food production, entrepreneurship, volunteering and cultural exchange on farm enterprises. The adults, especially 18-34 year olds, can then relate this online learning to practical residential work experience and informal learning on a range of small enterprises in different European countries.

EDVORG aims to develop and promote a Learning Guide as an online open educational resource for adult learners about organic food production, entrepreneurship, volunteering and cultural exchange on farm enterprises, so they can relate this to practical residential work experience and informal learning on a range of small enterprises in different European countries. This would be the first free European online education resource specifically on adult volunteering and organic food production on farm enterprises and targeted at non-professional adults.

The Learning Guide will be freely available and usable online on an "open educational resource" for anyone who wants to learn about organic food production, sustainable lifestyles, rural entrepreneurship, cultural understanding and volunteering on farm enterprises. It will help any entrepreneur or cooperative to set up a new small farm/garden enterprise (singularly or cooperatively) based on organic food production, as well as enable people to learn how to volunteer, live and work on a farm enterprise in a responsible, sustainable, safe and healthy way.


EDVORG project will last from September 1st 2014 – August 31st 2016 (two years in total). It is funded by EU Erasmus Plus Strategic Partnership programme, ref. Number: 2014-1-UK01-KA200-000047.

Executive Summary

WWOOF members of ten national WWOOF organisations in Europe (Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Norway, Serbia, Spain, Turkey and UK were asked to participate in an anonymous survey to help the project team to develop online Learning Guide as an "open educational resource".

The survey translated in 9 European languages was published online using Google forms platform¹. WWOOF members were delivered an email invitation for the both English and local language survey. Partners WWOOF Spain, WWOOF Italia, Amma published the news about the survey on their websites, as well as WWOOF Facebook page. Responses were being taken for two weeks from December 24th 2014 – January 08th 2015.

The survey included questions about members' experience in organic farming/sustainable living, their interests in subcategories of these two topics, and their willingness to contribute future Guide. A total of 1.822 responses were received from a total of 11.688 surveys mailed to members and more than 10.000 reach through the Facebook sharing and websites.

Methodology


The survey form was developed by Amma (Serbia) with an input from the brainstorming held during the partners' meeting in Turkey in October 2014. A preliminary draft of the survey was then sent to all partners, who were asked to respond to the questions and make suggestions for possible changes, additions, or deletions.

WWOOF members were asked to complete the final survey online.

After scanning, the responses were imported into Microsoft® Excel by the survey administrator. Errors were checked against the individual forms. Data analysis was completed using Excel.

Demographics per language





Motivation to learn about organic farming/sustainable living




Challenges with organic farming/sustainable living




How would you use the online resource on organic farming/sustainable living?
